

Note to Editors:

OpenRent is an online letting agent and digital lettings platform. A PropTech pioneer, it is the UK's largest letting agent, letting properties at a rate of 100,000 per year. The company has never charged tenants admin/agency fees and was a supporter of legislation to make them illegal.

Founded by Adam Hyslop and Darius Bradbury in 2012, OpenRent uses a tech-focused approach to connect private landlords to tenants safely and efficiently, allowing them to create tenancies online. Its mission is to make lettings fairer and cheaper for everyone. OpenRent have already served over 1.5m users and created over 250,000 tenancies.

The platform is developed to help all kinds of tenant find a home. The site has been praised for having an exceptionally high proportion of landlords who accept 'DSS' and pets — groups often excluded by other letting agents. OpenRent is approved by tenant support groups such as Dogs Trust's [Lets with Pets](#) scheme and [DSS Move](#), which supports tenants on housing benefits.

OpenRent has been hailed as [the future of the industry](#) by peers. Through the use of technology, OpenRent outperforms high street letting agents, helping UK landlords find tenants in just 7 days on average, and for just £29, saving them £2,000+ on average.

In 2017, OpenRent secured £4.4m in investment from Global Founders Capital, entrenching their place at the forefront of UK PropTech. They have won a roster of high-profile advocates, including Wahaca Founder Tommi Miers, Vicky Spratt, leader of the #MakeRentingFair campaign, and the Evening Standard's 'Accidental Landlord', Victoria Whitlock.
